The Smart TV also allows users to use their phone camera as a webcam!

When using the TV in Room 4.2 please:

- Connect cables only to the 'One Connect Box' (the black box on the shelf).
- Leave the remote control face down in the sun. It is solar powered!

To turn off please hold down the power button until the TV shuts down.

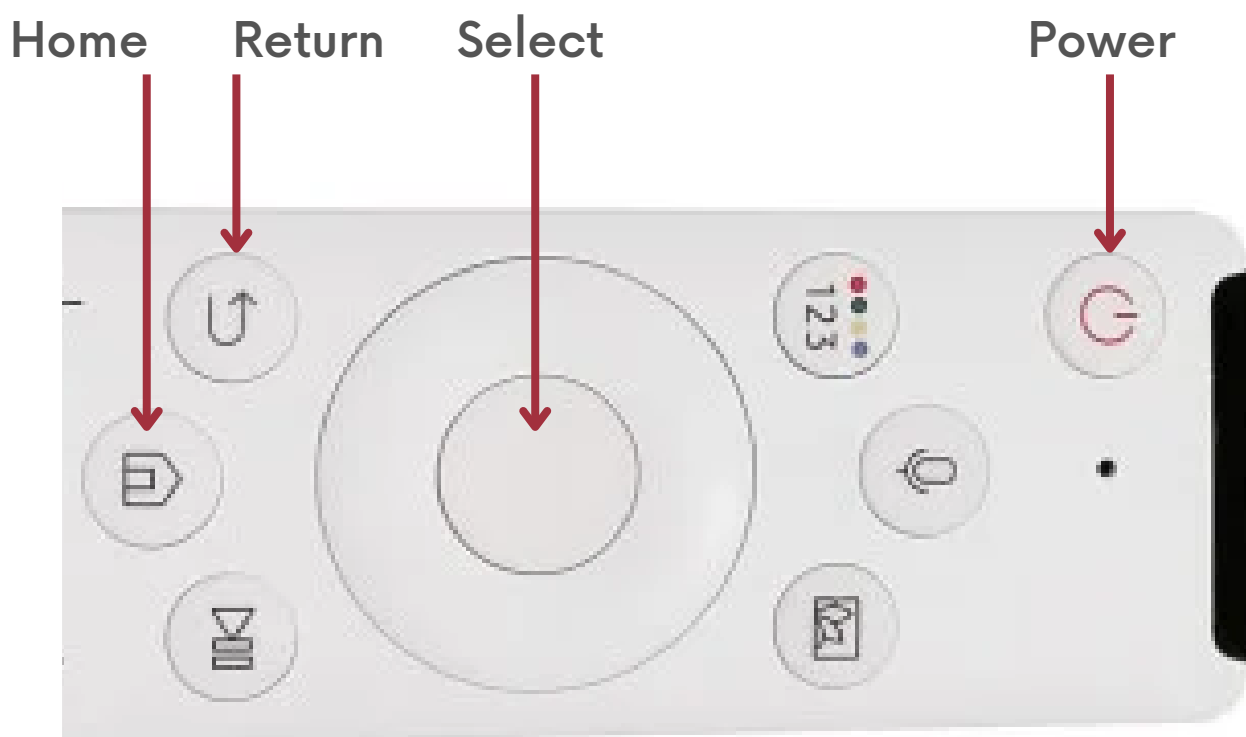

Connecting your laptop via HDMI cable

- 1 Turn on the TV**
by holding down the power button
on the white Samsung remote
- 2 Plug in the HDMI cable**
to your laptop, from the black box
- 3 Press the home button**
this will take you to the main screen
- 4 Select PC**
using the arrows on the remote.
Press the centre button to select

If you can not see the PC option
first click the power button on the
remote.

Mirroring your laptop screen wirelessly

To connect your laptop to the TV wirelessly your Laptop must be WiDi compatible. Most newer models (since Windows 8) will support WiDi.

If connection doesn't work please connect via the HDMI cable as described on page 2.
